three.



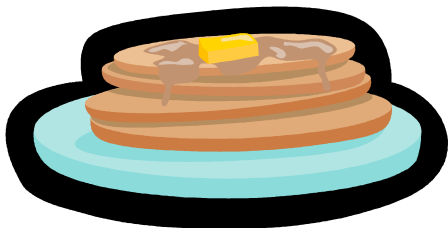
Three round pumpkins
